



Eligibility Requirements

For Recent Law Graduate to apply for temporary supervised admission applicants must:

- Be a December 2019 or 2020 graduate of an ABA accredited law school;
- Satisfy the provisions of Gov. Bar R. I(1) through (3) and have a Registration Application and Application to take the July 2020 bar examination submitted to the Office of Bar Admissions;
- Receive from the Board of Commissioners on Character and Fitness final approval of the applicant's character, fitness, and moral qualifications to practice;
- Practice under the supervision of an active Ohio attorney in good standing who has been licensed to practice law for at least three years;
- Not have failed a Bar Examination since their graduation from law school;
- Submit to the Office of Bar Admissions a form attesting that the applicant has read and agrees to be bound by the Ohio Rules of Professional Conduct;
- Complete and submit for approval to the Office of Bar Admissions an Application to Practice Pending Admission, on forms provided by that office.
